

ARE THEY THE SAME?

ABOLITION

- Uses plain legal and biblical language. Calls abortion murder.
- Founded and led solely by professing Christians; grounded in biblical principles.
- Believes prenatal murder must be abolished immediately under existing homicide law.
- Invokes the principle of nullification. Believes lawmakers have the legal right and the duty to ignore unconstitutional court rulings.
- Functions uncompromisingly. Insists through rhetoric and action that laws against murder must apply equally to prenatal and born humans, with no exceptions. All proposed bills align with the U.S. Constitution, Kansas Constitution, and God's Law.

PROLIFE

- Uses politically correct language: abortion “ends a human life” or “stops a beating heart.”
- Founded and led by secularists and religious individuals; guided by pragmatism and situational ethics.
- Believes abortion should be made unthinkable through social programs, marketing campaigns, and incremental legislation.
- Follows illicit court opinions. Supports legislation that violates the U.S. Constitution by allowing the execution of prenatal children without due process of law.
- Functions inconsistently. Claims abortion is wrong in principle but permits it in practice through ultrasound laws, gestational limits, parental consent, licensed doctors, “safe” clinics, etc.
